










The Southeastern Oratorio Society, now in its fifty-second year, is offering a program change on Monday, April 15th when their Spring concert features popular tunes from Broadway!

The St. James Speaker Series: Bonhoeffer in a Time of Responsibility

Tuesdays, April 16 - May 7, 2024 | 6:00 - 7:30 PM

The St. James Speaker Series is pleased to announce a very special upcoming four-part evening series on the writings and work of theologian Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Led by Bonhoeffer scholar, Dr. Wayne Floyd (husband of The Rev. Dr. Nancy Jose)), we invite you to join us on Tuesdays, beginning April 16 for Bonhoeffer In a Time of Responsibility, a present-day deep dive into the wisdom of one of Christian history's most important figures.

Series installments for April will be held in the Great Hall, 6:00-7:30pm, and will begin with a light dinner, followed by Wayne Floyd's presentation and concluding with a time for questions and brief closing Compline. The May 7 installment will be in the Lippitt Room over hors d'oeuvres and will be an



open group discussion/overview of the prior presentations; how Bonhoeffer's teachings share parallels with our current culture and "time of responsibility" as fellow Christians.

We invite you to share in this unique opportunity to hear and learn about Dietrich Bonhoeffer from one of the theologian's foremost authorities. While the series is open to all, reservations for dinner (\$15 per person) are required. RSVP instructions coming soon!



Look for God in nature.

- Walking a Christian journey doesn't have to begin in a building. "In fact, having now dedicated my life to helping build up these communities, it was the last place I wanted to be in the beginning. It took God's glorious creation to show me his majesty and to help me see myself through his eyes."
- **Get out into the world** in which we are stewards and find God among the rocks, leaves, animals, chirps, rain, rocks and rivers. God's creation is all around us. We only need to look. It is his gift to us, if only we can open our eyes and hearts to see its beauty.
- God's works are found in big cities too. If you look closely, even in the densest concrete jungle, you can find vibrant life in the cracks: small window gardens three stories up on an apartment balcony, a neighborhood garden squeezed in an alley way, a seedling pushing up through a crack in the concrete reaching up toward the sun.
